

Phone (919) 233-9767. **NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. **OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS:** For boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. **MASTER CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

From I-64 take Exit 53-B onto I-295 North. Then take Exit 49-A (Rt. 33 North). Go 3.6 miles, TURN LEFT onto Gordon's Lane (Rt. 730) and then TURN LEFT onto Dude Ranch Rd., bear right at a sign "Weasthoff Woods" and continue to the very end.

From I-95 take Exit 84-B onto I-295 North then follow above.

From Ashland Motels: Take SR 54 West to stoplight. TURN LEFT onto Rt. 1 South, go to 3rd stoplight (Sheetz Gas on corner) and TURN RIGHT onto Rt. 623 (Ashcake/Ashland Rd.), continue to Rt. 33 (Mountain Rd.) and TURN LEFT; go 0.7 mile to Gordon's Lane and TURN RIGHT, go 0.1 mile to Dude Ranch Rd. and TURN LEFT. NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All dogs present must be on a leash or confined to their crates, except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

Class cash prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that class is over, and the show-giving club disclaims any liability for cash prizes after the judging is over. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

The Central Virginia Collie Club, members, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for injury to or by children. Space for unentered dogs WILL NOT be provided at this show under conditions specified in Chapter 11, Section 11 of the Dog Show Rules and Regulations.

Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other conditions beyond the control of the host club it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on AKC entry forms and photographs of entry forms without Agreements and Rules on the reverse side are not acceptable.
